

GENERAL RULES

The solid black perimeter lines indicate where to cut the paper. The cut-out should be square.

Fold the paper so 1 touches 1, 2 touches 2, 3 touches 3, et cetera. Occasionally numbers will be supplemented with letters (ex: 7a and 7b). These indicate multiple points that need to touch in a single fold (ex: 7a must touch 7a, and 7b must touch 7b simultaneously).

Outlined numbers (ex: 1) are to be folded, creased, and unfolded. Overlined numbers (ex: $\overline{1}$) indicate that only the top layer of paper (and not all layers) are to be folded.


The gray lines and accompanying numbers in parentheses illustrate where each fold should crease the paper. After making each fold, double check that you did it correctly by unfolding it and ensuring the crease is in the right place.

Fold 1 to 1, crease, and unfold. Fold 2 to 2, crease, and unfold. Fold 3 to 3, crease, and unfold. Fold 4 to 4, crease, and unfold. Fold 5a to 5a, 5b to 5b, 5c to 5c, and 5d to 5d. Press flat. Fold 6 to 6, crease, and unfold. Fold 7a to 7a, and 7b to 7b. Fold 8 to 8, crease, and unfold. Fold 9a to 9a, and 9b to 9b.

Fold $\overline{10}$ to 10, crease, and unfold. Fold $\overline{11a}$ to 11a, and $\overline{11b}$ to 11b. Fold $\underline{12}$ to $\underline{12}$, crease, and unfold. Fold $\underline{13a}$ to 13a, and $\overline{13b}$ to 13b. Fold $\underline{14}$ to 14. Fold $\overline{15}$ to 15. Fold $\underline{16}$ to 16, crease, and unfold. Fold $\underline{17}$ to 17, crease, and unfold. Fold $\underline{18}$ to 18. Fold $\underline{19}$ to 19. Fold $\underline{20}$ to 20.

Fold $\overline{21}$ to 21. Fold $\overline{22a}$ to 22a, and $\overline{22b}$ to 22b. Fold $\overline{23a}$ to 23a, and 23b to 23b. Fold $\overline{24}$ to 24. Fold $\overline{25}$ to 25. Fold $\overline{26a}$ to 26a, and $\overline{26b}$ to 26b. Fold $\overline{27a}$ to 27a, and $\overline{27b}$ to 27b.

Carefully open the box by sticking a few fingers into the box and spreading the base so it lays flat.
